John White presided over the meeting. Meeting came to order at 2:10 p.m. The 2021 Ovid Union Meeting minutes were motioned to be accepted by Leon and seconded by Gertrude. Minutes accepted and approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Mark read the updated report and stated that it was an average year, operation wise. There were 11 interments and 3 lot sales. Donations, which allowed us to stay in the black last year, was a little over \$15,000 from 4 donors. There will be an invoice coming of approximately \$21,000 for the cutting down of diseased trees that was approved as a preventative measure at the last meeting. See attached report from Mark. Gertrude made a motion to accept the treasurer's report, John seconded, motion passed

BANK UPDATE: With the notification that the Willard branch is closing, discussion was made about switching banks. Mark will check out between the Community Bank and Five Star Bank in Ovid to see which will suit our needs best and report back at the next meeting.

PRESIDENTIAL REPORT: Fees - Discussion was had regarding increasing fees charged for burial, cremation, etc. The procedure is that we have to submit proposed changes to the State and they have to grant approval before becoming implemented (see attached proposed fees)

GROUNDS REPORT: Removal of diseased trees has been completed. Replacement trees are proposed to be planted. We are looking for a suitable supplier to purchase at least 4 foot high trees.

Clean-up date for this year is still yet to be determined. A notice is usually posted in the Shopper to make people aware of the upcoming date of clean-up. Usually it is completed before Memorial Day. Marty Brewer will need to be contacted to help in regards to the removal of the debris.

The 2 year Lawn Mowing bid has been accepted for this year by Matt Lincoln of \$13,100 plus \$500 surcharge for gas, this being the second year
